Comptroller's Assessor Elected to International Assessing Board

NASHVILLE, Tenn. – Gary T. Harris, assistant director in the Tennessee Comptroller's Office of State Assessed Properties, has been elected to the board of the International Association of Assessing Officers (IAAO).

Harris, a certified assessment examiner, will serve a two-year term on the IAAO board beginning in September. He was elected to the IAAO board in June with 84 percent of the vote. Harris will take office during the 70th Annual IAAO Conference in Boston Aug. 29-Sept. 1.

Harris, 53, annually supervises or personally appraises \$13 billion worth of public utility and transportation property in Tennessee. He earned the Tennessee certified assessor designation from the state Board of Equalization and the certified general real estate appraiser license conferred by the Tennessee Real Estate Commission.

He is a 1973 graduate of Middle Tennessee State University with a bachelor of science degree in industrial management.
