INDICTMENT

State of Tennessee, Davidson County

THE GRAND JURORS of Davidson County, Tennessee, duly impaneled and sworn, upon their oath, present that:

LARON BRIDGEFORTH

between the 1st day of July, 2014, and the 31st day of March, 2017, in Davidson County, Tennessee and before the finding of this indictment, knowingly did obtain or exercise control over certain property, to wit: a sum of money, of the value of \$10,000 or more but less than \$60,000, the property of Cumberland Elementary School, without the effective consent of Cumberland Elementary School, with the intent to deprive Cumberland Elementary School of the property, in violation of Tennessee Code Annotated § 39-14-103, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.
