

The Grand Jurors for the State of Tennessee, duly elected, impaneled, sworn, and charged to inquire in and for the body of the County of Fentress, in the State of Tennessee, upon their oath, present: That

KELLYE RHEA CRABTREE

prior to the finding of this indictment, on or about December 15, 2014 - December 31, 2018, in the County and State aforesaid, did unlawfully, feloniously, and knowingly obtain or exercise control over the property of the government of Fentress County, of a value of an amount of sixty-thousand (\$60,000) dollars or more but less than two-hundred- fifty thousand (\$250,000) dollars, with the intent to deprive the owner thereof and without the owner's effective consent, in violation of T.C.A. 39-14-103, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.
