

The Grand Jurors of the State of Tennessee, duly elected, impaneled, sworn and charged to inquire in and for the body of the County of CARROLL, in the State aforesaid, upon their oath present:

That THOMAS A. TANSIL, JR., heretofore, to-wit: on or between the 1st day of August, 2017 and the 31st day of January, 2020, before the finding of this indictment, in the County and State aforesaid, then and there did unlawfully and knowingly exercise control over property, to wit: compensation for falsely claimed travel, salary, and paid annual, sick or military leave, the value of \$10,000.00 or more but less than \$60,000.00, of State of Tennessee without effective consent, with intent to deprive the said State of Tennessee thereof, in violation of T.C.A. § 39-14-103, all of which is against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.





That THOMAS A. TANSIL, JR., heretofore, to-wit: on or between the 1st day of August, 2017 and the 31st day of January, 2020, before the finding of this indictment, in the County and State aforesaid, then and there, while being a public servant, to-wit: Assistant District Attorney General, intentionally or knowingly with intent to obtain a benefit, did commit an act, to wit: filing false travel claims, salary, and paid annual, sick, or military leave, relating to the servant's office or employment that constitutes an unauthorized exercise of official power, in violation of T.C.A. § 39-16-402, all of which is against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.



The Grand Jurors of the State of Tennessee, duly elected, impaneled, sworn and charged to inquire in and for the body of the County of CARROLL, in the State aforesaid, upon their oath present:

That THOMAS A. TANSIL, JR., heretofore, to-wit: on or between the 1st day of August, 2017 and the 31st day of January, 2020, before the finding of this indictment, in the County and State aforesaid, then and there, did unlawfully and knowingly, directly or indirectly, access, cause to be accessed, or attempt to access any telephone system, telecommunications facility, computer software, computer program, data, computer, computer system, computer network or any part thereof, for the purpose of obtaining money, property, or services for himself or another by means of false or fraudulent pretense, representation, or promise, in violation of T.C.A. § 39-14-602, all of which is against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.
