## **COUNT 1**

THE GRAND JURORS of Davidson County, Tennessee, duly impaneled and sworn, upon their oath, present that:

**ADLENITA L. SHUTE**


between the **23rd** day of **January, 2019**, and the **4th** day of **March, 2019**, in Davidson County, Tennessee and before the finding of this indictment, knowingly did obtain or exercise control over certain property, to wit: **U.S. currency**, of the value of **\$2,500 or more but less than \$10,000**, the property of **Isaiah T. Creswell, PTSO**, without the effective consent of **Isaiah T. Creswell, PTSO**, with the intent to deprive **Isaiah T. Creswell, PTSO** of the property, in violation of Tennessee Code Annotated § 39-14-103, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

**COUNT 2**

THE GRAND JURORS of Davidson County, Tennessee, duly impaneled and sworn, upon their oath, present that:

**ADLENITA L. SHUTE**

between the **23rd** day of **January, 2019**, and the **4th** day of **March, 2019**, in Davidson County, Tennessee and before the finding of this indictment, with fraudulent intent, did intentionally or knowingly use or allow to be used a credit or debit card, or information from a credit or debit card, the property of **Isaiah T. Creswell, PTSO** to obtain property, credit, or services, to wit: **U.S. currency**, the value of **\$2,500 or more but less than \$10,000** with knowledge that the card was **unauthorized for use by either the issuer or the person to whom it was issued**, in violation of Tennessee Code Annotated § 39-14-118, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.
