The Grand Jurors of Humphreys County, Tennessee, duly elected, impaneled, sworn, and charged to inquire, find that between November 1, 2010 and April 30, 2019, in Humphreys County, Tennessee, **JEFFREY VAN STAGGS**, did unlawfully, knowingly and feloniously obtain or exercise control over property, money a further description to the Grand Jurors aforesaid unknown, over the value of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) but less than sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000.00), of the Humphreys County Volunteer Fire Department, without their effective consent, with the intent to deprive said the Humphreys County Volunteer Fire Department, thereof, in violation of T.C.A. 39-14-103, a Class C Felony, all of which is against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

COUNT TWO:

And the Grand Jurors, do further present and say, between November 1, 2010 and April 30, 2019, in Humphreys County, Tennessee, **JEFFREY VAN STAGGS**, being a public servant, with the intent to obtain a benefit or to harm another, did unlawfully, feloniously, intentionally or knowingly commit an act relating to his office or employment that constitutes an unauthorized exercise of official power, commit an act under color of office or employment that exceeds the servant's official power, refrains from performing a duty that is imposed by law or that is clearly inherent in the nature of the public servant's office or employment, violates a law relating to the public servant's office or employment or receives any benefit not otherwise authorized by law, in violation of T.C.A. 39-16-402, a Class E Felony, all of which is against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

COUNT THREE:

And the Grand Jurors, do further present and say, between November 1, 2010 and April 30, 2019, in Humphreys County, Tennessee, **JEFFREY VAN**

STAGGS, did unlawfully and intentionally destroy, conceal, remove or otherwise impair the verity, legibility or availability of a governmental record, in violation of T.C.A. 39-16-504, a Class A Misdemeanor, all of which is against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.
