

Smith** between December 31, 2015 and August 1, 2019, in Franklin County, Tennessee, and before the finding of this indictment, did unlawfully, knowingly (obtain control of) (exercise control over) good and lawful U.S. currency, being the personal goods and property of **City of Decherd, TN**, without the owner's effective consent and with the intent to deprive the true owner thereof, the value of said personal goods and property being at least \$10,000.00 but less than \$60,000.00; in violation of **T.C.A. 39-14-103**, all of which is against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.


