COUNT 1

The Grand Jurors for the State of Tennessee, duly elected, impaneled, sworn, and charged to inquire in and for the body of the County of Fentress, in the State of Tennessee, upon their oath, present: That

JOHNNY CARSON DISHMAN


prior to the finding of this indictment, on or about January 01, 2017 - March 13, 2020, in the County and State aforesaid, did unlawfully, feloniously, knowingly and without the effective consent of the owner, obtain or exercise control over the property of the government of Fentress County, with the intent to deprive the said owner of the property, valued at more than \$2,500, in violation of TCA §39-14-103, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

COUNT 2

And the Grand Jurors aforesaid, upon their oaths aforesaid, do further present: That **JOHNNY CARSON DISHMAN** prior to the finding of this indictment, on or about January 01, 2017 - March 13, 2020, in the County and State aforesaid, did unlawfully, feloniously, and knowingly used a credit or debit card without the consent of the owner for the purpose of obtaining property, credit, services, or anything else of value, with knowledge the use of the card was unauthorized, to wit: purchasing fuel for personal use, in violation of T.C.A. §39-14-118, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

COUNT 3

And the Grand Jurors aforesaid, upon their oaths aforesaid, do further present: That **JOHNNY CARSON DISHMAN**, a public servant, prior to the finding of this indictment, on or about January 01, 2017 - March 13, 2020, in the County and State aforesaid, did unlawfully, feloniously, intentionally, and knowingly, and with intent to obtain a benefit commit an act, relating to his office or employment that constituted an unauthorized exercise of official power, in violation of T.C.A. §39-16-402, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.




