CHARGE: THEFT OVER \$2,500

COUNT 1

The Grand Jurors for the CRIMINAL COURT for HAWKINS COUNTY, TENNESSEE, meeting on August 15<sup>th</sup>, 2022, in ROGERSVILLE, after being duly sworn upon their oath present that STACY HAWKINS MAYES on or about March 24, 2021, and continuing through October 4, 2021, in the State and County aforesaid, and before the finding of this indictment, did unlawfully commit the offense of THEFT OF PROPERTY OVER TWO THOUSAND, FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$2,500.00) BUT LESS THAN TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$10,000.00) by knowingly obtaining or exercising control over city funds totaling two thousand, nine hundred, and forty-one dollars (\$2,941.00) without the owner, the City of Church Hill's, effective consent and with the intent to deprive the owner thereof; a Class D felony, in violation of Tenn. Code Ann. § 39-14-103, 105, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.
