

COUNT 1:

COUNT 2:

The Grand Jurors of the State of Tennessee, duly elected, impaneled, sworn and charged to inquire in and for the body of the County of HARDIN, in the State aforesaid, upon their oath present:

That STEVEN DAVID CROMWELL, heretofore, to-wit: On or about JANUARY, 2021, before the finding of this indictment, in the County aforesaid, then and there did intentionally or knowingly make a false entry in, or false alteration of, a government record BY FALSIFYING TWO PURCHASE ORDERS, TWO INVOICES AND ACCOUNTING RECORDS OF THE SAVANNAH HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT IN ORDER TO CIRCUMVENT BID REQUIREMENTS FOR AN EQUIPMENT PURCHASE, thereby committing the offense of DESTRUCTION OF AND TAMPERING WITH GOVERNMENTAL RECORDS, in violation of T.C.A. §39-13-213(a)(2), against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.
