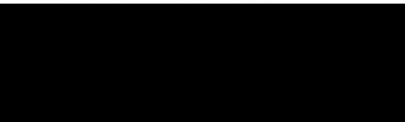

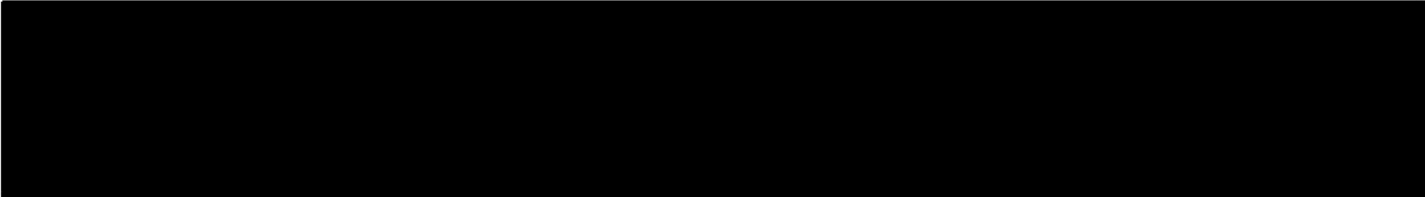


COUNT 2

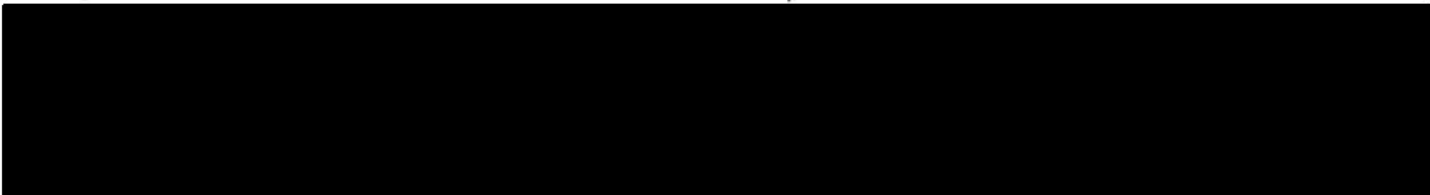


COUNT 3
