THE JULY SESSION of Circuit Court, 2024, ROBERT CARTER,
being duly elected District Attorney for BEDFORD County,
Tennessee, acting under the authority of Section 40-3-103,
Tennessee Code Annotated, charges that:

ROBERT PAUL CROSS

between the dates of JANUARY 1, 2021 and JANUARY 1, 2024, in
BEDFORD County, Tennessee, and prior to this Criminal
Information, knowingly did obtain or exercise control over
certain property, to-wit: UNITED STATES CURRENCY, of the
value of TEN THOUSAND (\$10,000) DOLLARS OR MORE BUT LESS THAN
SIXTY THOUSAND (\$60,000) DOLLARS, the property of STATE OF
TENNESSEE, without the effective consent of the STATE OF
TENNESSEE, with the intent to deprive the STATE OF TENNESSEE
of the property, in violation of Tennessee Code Annotated §39-
14-103, and against the peace and dignity of the State of
Tennessee.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

By agreement of the parties as evidenced by the signatures placed hereinbelow, the following shall be specific conditions which shall be abided by during the pendency of this prosecution:

1. The parties agree that this matter may commence via a criminal information. Specifically, the defendant agrees to waive presentation of this matter to the Bedford County Grand Jury.

2. The defendant agrees to pay restitution of \$11,130.00 and court costs in the amount of \$659.00 for a total amount of \$11,789.00.

3. The defendant agrees to make monthly payments in the amount of \$2,357.80 to the clerk's office in each of the months of August, September, October, November and December, 2024.

4. The defendant shall obey the laws of the United States and any state which he may be in as well as any municipal ordinance.

5. The State of Tennessee agrees that upon full repayment of the restitution and court costs in this matter to a dismissal of the criminal information.

6. The clerk's office shall distribute the restitution to the following entity:


