Count 1: [Theft of Property over \$10,000]

THE GRAND JURORS of Putnam County, Tennessee, duly empaneled and sworn upon their oath present that ROSEMARY LEA DOWNS heretofore between November 1, 2022 and March 30, 2024, in Putnam County, Tennessee, and before the finding of this indictment, did unlawfully and knowingly, with the intent to deprive, without the owner's effective consent, the Upperman Fishing Booster Club of money belonging to said club, obtained or exercised control over money belonging to the Upperman Fishing Booster Club and used the same for her own personal use, in violation of *Tenn. Code Ann. § 39-14-103* and against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

Count 2: [Forgery]

THE GRAND JURORS of Putnam County, Tennessee, duly empaneled and sworn upon their oath present that ROSEMARY LEA DOWNS heretofore between November 1, 2022 and March 30, 2024, in Putnam County, Tennessee, and before the finding of this indictment, did unlawfully and knowingly and with the intent to defraud or harm the Upperman Fishing Booster Club, did make, complete, execute or authenticate the endorsements on checks drawn on the bank account of the Upperman High School Fishing Team Booster Club, so that said endorsement purports to be the act of another who did not authorize the act, in violation of Tenn. Code. Ann. § 39-14-114, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.
