



COUNT ONE

THE GRAND JURORS of Warren County, Tennessee, duly impaneled and sworn, upon their oath, present that:

JAMIE LEE BRANIN

Between the dates of October 20, 2017 and March 8, 2024, in Warren County, Tennessee, and before the finding of this indictment, knowingly did obtain or exercise control over certain property, to wit: United States Currency, over the value of \$1,000.00, but less than \$2,500.00 the property of Warren County High School, and without the effective consent of the said Warren County High School and with the intent to deprive Warren County High School of said property, constituting the offense of Theft of Property over \$1,000.00 but less than \$2,500.00, a Class "E" Felony in violation of Tennessee Code Annotated § 39-14-103, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.
