The Grand Jurors of MAURY County, Tennessee, duly impaneled, and sworn upon their oath, present: That CHRISTIAN NASH between the 1st day of January, 2023 and the 12th day of May, 2024, in MAURY County, Tennessee and before the finding of this indictment, by the use of a credit/debit card issued to Columbia Power and Water Systems, obtain property, credit, services or anything else of value in the amount of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) or more but less than Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00) knowing at the time that the use of the aforesaid credit/debit card was not authorized by the said business Columbia Power and Water Systems, in violation of Tennessee Code Annotated Section 39-14-118, all of which is against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.
