COUNT ONE

The Grand Jurors of GILES County, Tennessee, duly impaneled, and sworn upon their oath, present: That FREDDIE C. BYRD between the 1st day of January, 2017 and the 31st day of December, 2023, in GILES County, Tennessee and before the finding of this indictment, knowingly did obtain or exercise control over certain property, to wit: United States currency of the value of more than \$2,500.00 (Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars) but less than \$10,000.00 (Ten Thousand Dollars), the property of Tarpley Shop Utility District, without the effective consent of Tarpley Shop Utility District, with the intent to deprive Tarpley Shop Utility District of the property, in violation of Tennessee Code Annotated Section 39-14-103, all of which is against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

COUNT TWO

The Grand Jurors of GILES County, Tennessee, duly impaneled, and sworn upon their oath, present: That FREDDIE C. BYRD between the 1st day of January, 2017 and the 31st day of December, 2023, in GILES County, Tennessee and before the finding of this indictment, did unlawfully, while acting as a public servant, and knowingly and with intent to obtain a benefit, did violate a law relating to the defendant's office or employment, in violation of Tennessee Code Annotated 39-16-402, all of which is against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

COUNT THREE

The Grand Jurors of GILES County, Tennessee, duly impaneled, and sworn upon their oath, present: That FREDDIE C. BYRD between the 1st day of January, 2017 and the 31st day of December, 2023, in GILES County, Tennessee and before the finding of this indictment, did unlawfully, while acting as a public servant, and knowingly and with intent to obtain a benefit, did receive a benefit not otherwise authorized by law, in violation of Tennessee Code Annotated 39-16-402, all of which is against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.
