THE GRAND JURORS of the State of Tennessee, duly selected, empaneled, sworn and charged to inquire for the body of the county of Shelby, Tennessee, upon their oath, present that:

BRODERICK WEBSTER

between January 01, 2023 and August 01, 2023 in Shelby County, Tennessee, and before the finding of this indictment, did unlawfully and knowingly obtain or exercise control over certain property, to wit: a sum of money, of the value of \$10,000 or more but less than \$60,000, the property of TENNESSEE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES, without the effective consent of TENNESSEE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES, with intent to deprive TENNESSEE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES of the said property, in violation of T.C.A. 39-14-103, against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.
