The Grand Jurors for the State of Tennessee, having been duly summoned, elected, impaneled, sworn, and charged to inquire for the body of the County and State aforesaid, present that MATTHEW BALLARD on or about between October 1, 2018 and November 5, 2022, said conduct having been concealed by the said MATTHEW BALLARD when he directed district employees to document work performed for the said MATTHEW BALLARD'S benefit be disguised as work performed for the benefit of the district, until its revelation on January 25, 2023, before the finding of this indictment in the State and County aforesaid, being a public servant with the intent to obtain a benefit, did unlawfully, feloniously, intentionally or knowingly commit an act relating to the servant's office, the said MATTHEW BALLARD did receive a benefit not otherwise authorized by law, to-wit: the fraudulent receipt of \$18,581.27 in goods and services to which he was not entitled, in violation of T.C.A. 40-2-103 and T.C.A. 39-16-402(a)(5), a class E Felony, contrary to the statute, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.
