RESULTS

Our report on Van Buren County's financial statements is unmodified.

Our audit resulted in **four findings** and recommendations, which we have reviewed with Van Buren County management. Detailed findings, recommendations, and management's responses are included in the Single Audit section of this report.

FINDINGS BY OFFICE

The following are summaries of the audit findings:

Office of County Mayor and Director of Schools

• Some general ledger payroll deduction accounts were not reconciled with payroll reports and payments.

Offices of County Clerk

• The office did not implement adequate controls to protect its information resources.


Office of Circuit and General Sessions Court Clerk

• The general sessions court clerk did not post short-term investment account activity to the accounting records.

Office of Sheriff

• Fees were not reported and paid to the county in compliance with state statute.
