We have audited the basic financial statements of Obion County as of and for the year ended June 30, 2025.

RESULTS

Our report on Obion County's financial statements is unmodified.

Our audit resulted in **five findings** and recommendations, which we have reviewed with Obion County management. Detailed findings, recommendations, and management's responses are included in the Single Audit section of this report.

FINDINGS BY OFFICE

The following are summaries of the audit findings:

Office of County Mayor

- The General Fund required material audit adjustments for proper financial statement presentation.
- Obion County employed a contractor without requiring adequate bonds in accordance with state statute.

Office of Highway Superintendent

- Competitive bids were not solicited for the purchase of dump trucks.

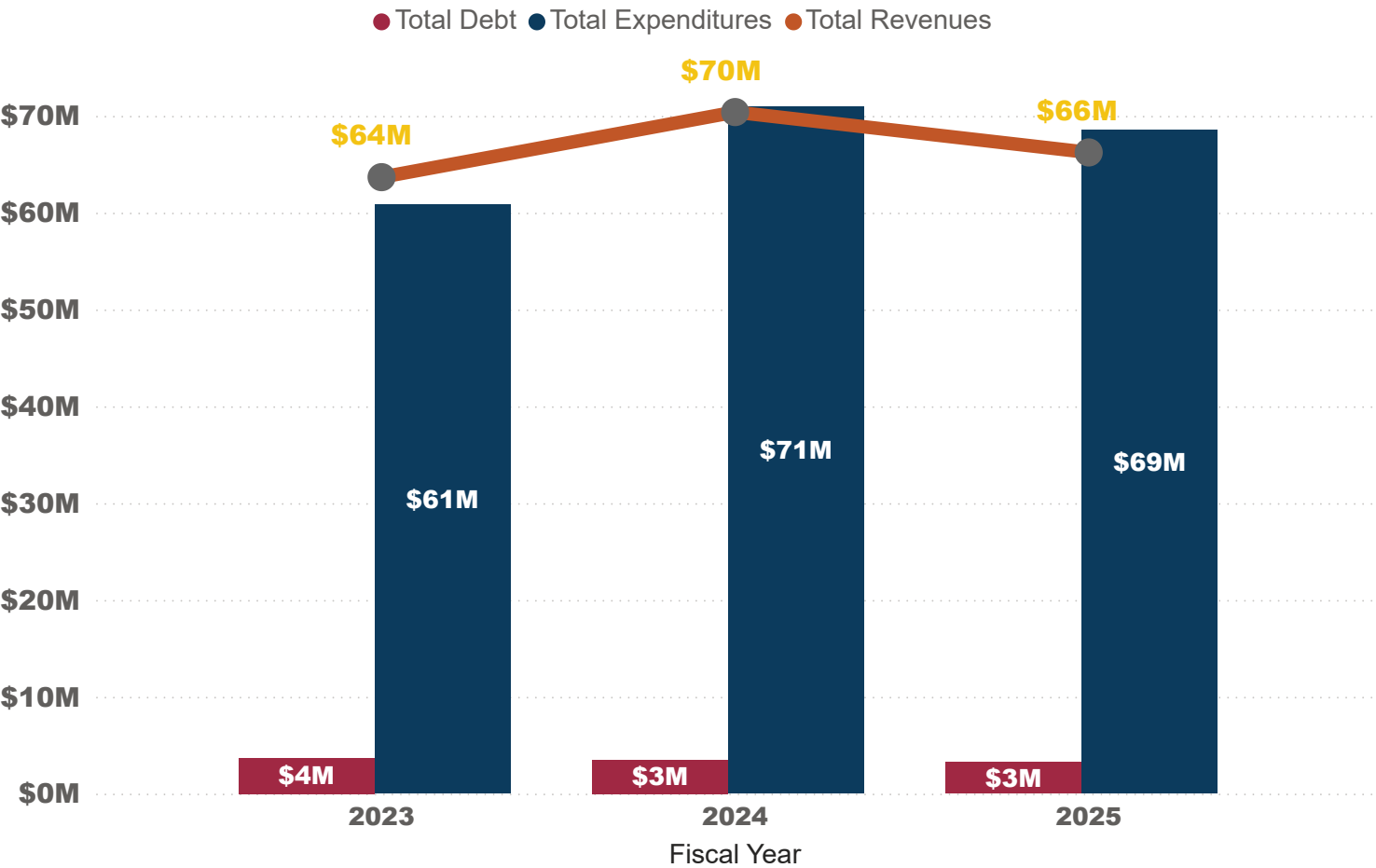
Office of Director of Schools

- The school department did not employ a registered architect or engineer for a roofing project.

Office of Sheriff

- The office had accounting deficiencies.
