RESULTS

Our report on Washington County's financial statements is unmodified.

Our audit resulted in **five findings** and recommendations, which we have reviewed with Washington County management. Detailed findings, recommendations, and management's responses are included in the Single Audit section of this report.

FINDINGS BY OFFICE

The following are summaries of the audit findings:

Offices of Director of Accounts and Budgets and Director of Schools

A wire transfer of \$335,215.10 was made to a fictitious company as the result of a phishing scheme.

Offices of County Mayor, Director of Accounts and Budgets, and Trustee

• An improperly executed contract led to an unauthorized debit from the trustee's bank account.


Office of Director of Schools

• The accounting records for various funds had not been properly maintained.

Office of Trustee

- The office had accounting deficiencies.
- The monthly trustee's report was not completed and filed in compliance with state statute.
