Staying in the Know

The Deadline is Approaching

Our CMFO/CCFO free CPE event this past fall was a huge success. It was a privilege for me to get out and shake your hand and put a name with a face. I appreciate the many of you that attended our inagural free CPE event and look forward to meeting more of you at this year's event. Don't forget to make sure your email address is up to date in our CMFO Act System and that you have chosen your preferred email so that we may send the invitation for this year's event to the correct email.

There are some important changes that need to be reiterated for this issue of the newsletter concerning the status of your CMFO Act account. There are many of you that still have not reported CPE for 2021. The deadline for

reporting CPE taken in 2021 is March 1st. Your account will be placed in inactive status if you have not reported by the deadline. If your account is placed in inactive status, you may not present yourself as a CMFO either in writing or orally or display your certificate until your account has been reactivated.

To reactivate, you complete and properly report 16 hours to apply towards the 2021 delinquent CPE hours. This is in addition to the 16 CPE hours that you will be responsible to obtain in 2022 and report by December 31, 2022, to maintain an active status. An inactive status places municipality out-ofyour compliance with the CMFO Act and subject to penalties if you are the individual designated as having oversight responsibilities for your city/town. A CMFO can remain in an inactive status for up to two consecutive years



from the last renewal deadline (December 31) as an active CMFO. After that period, the CMFO certification account is closed and is no longer eligible to reactivate and must reapply as a new candidate to attain the certification again.

What Qualifies as Live CPE?

Many of you have asked about the new requirement for live CPE. A virtual event (given online) can qualify as a live event if it is provided

in real time where each participant is given the opportunity to ask the instructor questions and attendance is taken by either CPE codes, attendance checks, or knowledge-based test at the end of the session. There will be exceptions granted for online CPE courses at the discretion of the Comptroller's Office. If you have any questions on whether a particular online CPE course offering is eligible for credit, please contact our office.

If you need assistance on finding upcoming live events near your location, please send me an email of the timeframe you are wanting to attend and location. We hope to see many of you at our annual free CPE event later this year but realize that time schedules may not permit. The best advice that I can give you is don't wait if you can get your CPE earlier in the year.

What interested you in the CMFO program?


