Tenn. Code Ann. § 9-21-134

## **New Online Reporting and Submission Process**

When public entities borrow money, including conduit borrowings, the public entity issuing the debt must file a Debt Report with its governing body within 45 days following the issuance or execution of the debt, with a copy (including attachments, if any) filed with the Division of Local Government Finance. See Tenn. Code Ann. § 9-21-134.

We are excited to share the release of our new online submission process for Debt Reports. The online form may be accessed on our website at <u>tncot.cc/debt-report</u> by clicking on the "FiscalFit Submit Debt Report" button.

Once you click the button you can begin your submission process by choosing the Tennessee governmental entity that has recently issued debt. From there you will find instructions and tool tips throughout your submission process. 
