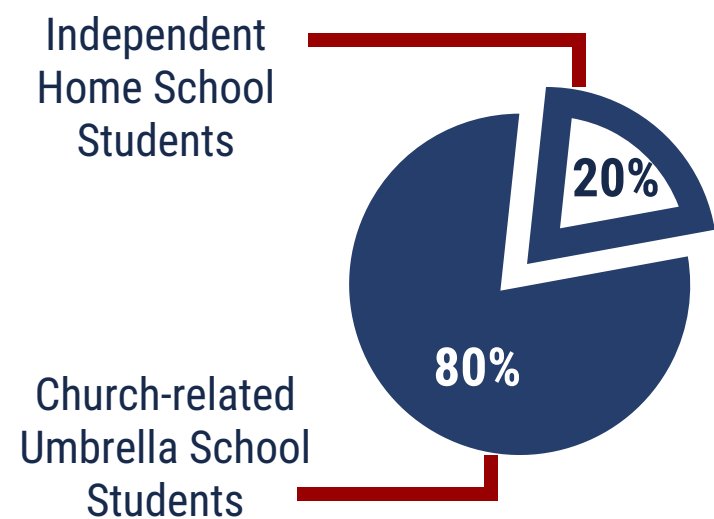

There are **2** ways to  
home school in TN.

OREA estimates there were **37,000**  
**to 42,000** home school students  
for the 2016-17 school year.



Both types of home school students  
are eligible for HOPE, TN Promise,  
and the TCAT Reconnect Grant.

State and local government & public  
higher education must treat all home  
school diplomas as equal to public  
school diplomas.



As of 2015, both types of home school  
students are eligible for TSSAA sports.
