

In addition to the TISA funding calculations, TISA includes two additional funding categories: 1) educator salary increases and 2) fast-growth funds. Both categories are funded 100 percent by the state.

Educator Salary Increases

Funds can only be used to increase existing educators' salaries.



Funds are awarded based on each district's proportional share of statewide student enrollment.



The State Board of Education is required to increase the minimum teacher salary every year in alignment with appropriation increases.

Fast-Growth Funds

School districts with fast-growing student populations may qualify for one or both fast-growth funding opportunities.

Purpose	Additional funding for districts with significant student enrollment growth in a single school year.	Additional funding for districts with significant student enrollment growth over a three-year period.
Eligibility	For districts with more than 1.25 percent growth in the total TISA allocations (as generated by student enrollment) in a single school year.	For districts with student enrollment growth that exceeds 2 percent every year for three consecutive years.
