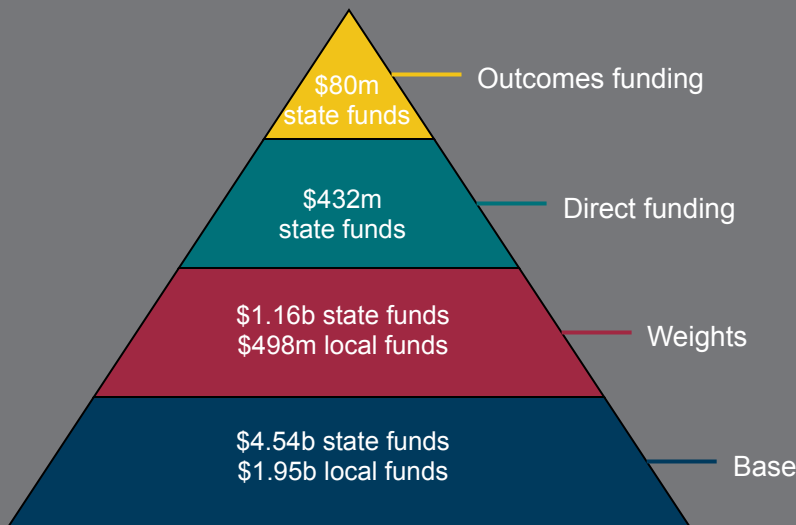

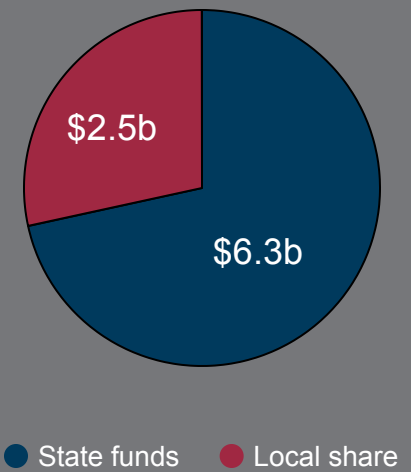

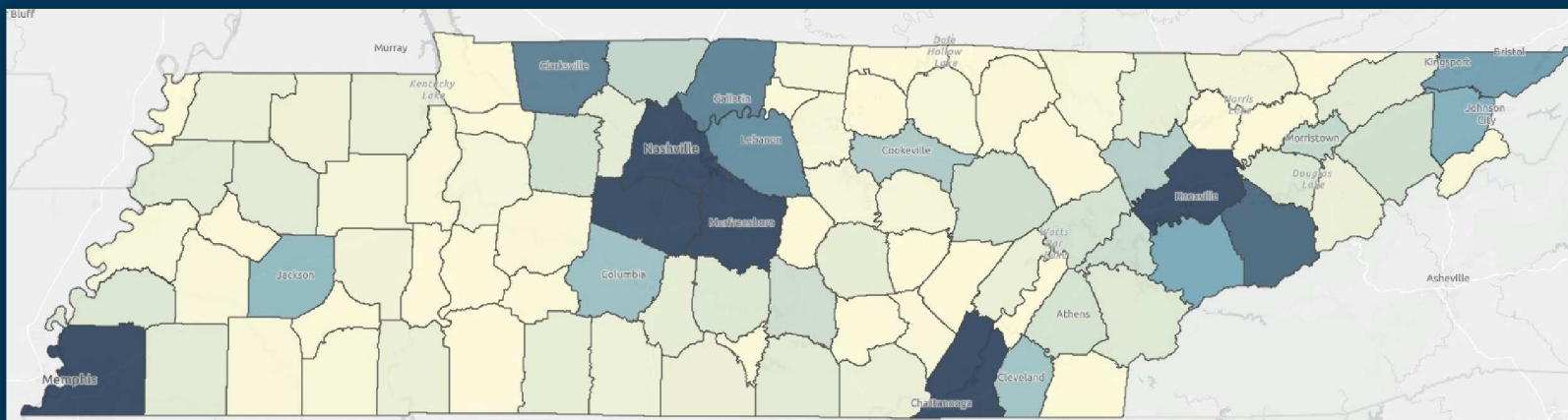

Fiscal capacity by county

Fiscal capacity is used to estimate the ability of a county to contribute financially to K-12 education. Counties with higher fiscal capacity are required to contribute more local funds than districts with lower fiscal capacity.

Darker shades indicate counties with a higher fiscal capacity.
