

# TISA Direct Funding

**Direct funding provides targeted support for students in key priority areas. Direct funding is 100 percent state-funded and does not require a local contribution. Totals for each category are based on 2024-25 funding amounts.**

The TISA formula uses average daily membership (ADM) to calculate student counts for most funding elements, which accounts for each student's enrollment and daily class schedule across nine reporting periods.

## K-3 literacy

Funding is intended to support early literacy instruction

**\$500** per eligible student ADM for **all students grades K-3**



## Charter schools

The annual appropriation for charter schools is divided across all public charter schools based on student enrollment

**~\$500** per eligible student ADM for **all charter students**

## Grade 4 literacy support

Funding is intended to provide students with additional literacy-related supports, such as tutoring and other interventions

**\$500** per eligible student for **qualifying grade 4 students**

## Career and technical education (CTE)

Funding is for students who participate in CTE courses

**\$5,000** per eligible CTE ADM for **students enrolled in CTE courses**

## ACT funding

Funding for students to take the ACT in 11th grade and one retake in 12th grade

**\$93** per eligible student ADM for **all students in grades 11 and 12** (up to \$186 per ADM)

In 2023-24 and 2024-25, direct funding for CTE under TISA was \$5,000 per CTE ADM. Beginning in the 2025-26 school year, direct funding for CTE is allocated based on the **level** of the CTE program and the **student year progression** in coursework through the program.
