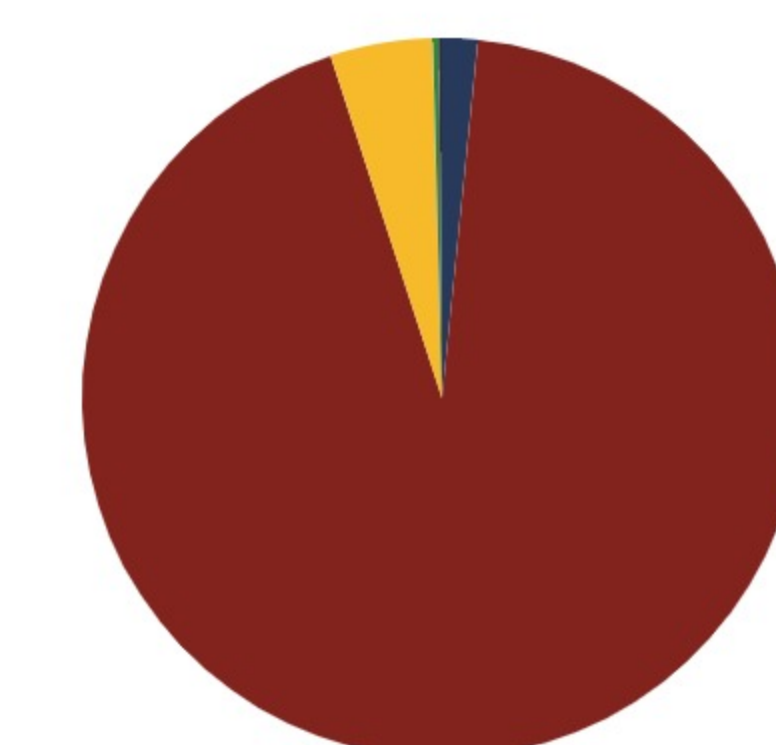
Funding Sources
