## **MEMORANDUM**

**TO:** County Mayors/County Executives

**FROM:** Jason E. Mumpower, Comptroller of the Treasury

**SUBJECT:** Local Redistricting and Reapportionment

September marks the start of the redistricting process across Tennessee. By now, someone has contacted your county to determine the level of assistance needed in this process. You also should have recently received our publication, *A Guide to Local Government Redistricting in Tennessee*. Additionally, on our website, you can find the following documents and forms to assist in the redistricting process:

- Sample Resolution To Establish a Redistricting Committee
- Sample Resolution To Adopt a Reapportionment/Redistricting Plan
- Sample Resolution To Remove Prison Population

Please remember that redistricting must be complete by **January 1, 2022**. To assist in this process, you have, or will be receiving, the following from our Office or CTAS:

- 3 large format maps showing current commission districts, voting precincts, and the 2020 population and demographic data
- 10 small format maps showing the deviations for each district in your county

The Comptroller's Office has produced a digital <u>dashboard</u> showing the 2020 total population, ideal population, deviation, and percent deviation per district in every county.

Assistance with redistricting will be available from CTAS, our Office, or someone within your county government. You can verify your level of assistance by using our interactive <u>dashboard</u> and selecting your county to the left.
