
**TENNESSEE LOCAL DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY
NOTICE OF MEETING**

The Tennessee Local Development Authority will meet on Tuesday, June 15, 2021, at 2:45 p.m. CDT, or immediately following the Tennessee Local Development Authority Audit Committee meeting, whichever is later, in the State Capitol, Ground Floor, Executive Conference Room, Nashville.

The agenda items for the Tennessee Local Development Authority meeting include:

- Consideration of a request for approval from the Water Authority of Dickson County to issue Revenue Refunding and Improvement Bonds, Series 2021, in an amount not to exceed \$23,000,000, and to simultaneously repay all its outstanding SRF loans in their entirety
- Consideration of a request for approval from the City of Franklin to issue Water and Sewer System Revenue Bonds in an amount not to exceed \$22,000,000 senior to its outstanding SRF loans
- Consideration of a request for approval from the Smith Utility District to issue a USDA Waterworks Revenue Bond in an amount not to exceed \$1,200,000 subordinate to its outstanding SRF loans
- Consideration of a request for approval from the Big Creek Utility District to issue Waterworks Revenue and Refunding Bonds in an amount not to exceed \$300,000 subordinate to its outstanding SRF loans
- Consideration of a request for approval from the Griffith Creek Utility District of Marion County to issue Waterworks Revenue Refunding Bonds in an amount not to exceed \$300,000 subordinate to its outstanding SRF loan
- Report on SRF fund balance to reflect addition of the capitalization grants:
 - Clean Water SRF Balance
 - Drinking Water SRF Balance

Roll-call vote is anticipated due to telephone participation by Board members, Mr. Pat Wolfe, Senate Appointee, and Mayor Paige Brown, House Appointee.
