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Over the last several years, Tennessee has increased financial investments in the state's Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs across the K-12 and postsecondary education systems. A primary goal of these increased investments is to increase the skilled workforce available to high-demand industries in the state. Another goal is to help K-12 students learn about, experience, and consider potential careers and the education pathways that are needed to reach them.

Accomplishing these goals requires the persistent building of strong connections and partnerships between education systems and local businesses and industries throughout the state. These efforts may also help bolster the state's college-going rates, which have declined over the last few years. This brief highlights two state initiatives that emphasize such partnerships: the Supporting Postsecondary Access in Rural Communities (SPARC) grant and the Innovative School Models (ISM) grant.

Supporting Postsecondary Access in Rural Communities (SPARC)

The SPARC grant program was created to help meet the CTE infrastructure needs of Tennessee's at-risk and distressed rural counties and provide greater access to higher education and dual enrollment opportunities in rural communities.^A

The 2020 Tennessee Higher Education Commission (THEC) Master Plan Update notes that "the diverse needs of local workforces require targeted, specific supports to increase attainment, particularly in economically distressed or at-risk counties." Counties are categorized as at-risk or distressed by the Appalachian Regional Commission index of economic status. Designations are based on counties' three-year average unemployment rate, per capita market income, and poverty rates. Distressed counties rank among the 10 percent most economically distressed in the U.S. while at-risk counties rank between the bottom 10 percent and 25 percent of the nation's counties.^B

The General Assembly appropriated state funds for the first of three rounds of the SPARC grant program in 2019 and followed up with two more rounds in 2021 and 2023. State-allocated funds for the three rounds total \$22.5 million.

The SPARC grants, administered by THEC, were distributed in three rounds:^C

- SPARC 2.0 in 2019: \$2 million for at-risk and distressed counties (\$36,000 each for 24 at-risk counties; \$75,000 each for 15 distressed counties)
- SPARC 3.0 in 2021: \$11.5 million for at-risk and distressed counties (\$124,703 each for 30 at-risk counties; \$223,825 each for nine distressed counties)^D
- SPARC 4.0^E in 2023: \$10 million for transitional, at-risk, and distressed counties (\$95,158 each for 49 transitional^F counties; \$102,000 each for 32 at-risk counties; \$139,880 each for 10 distressed counties).^G

^A SPARC funds have also been allocated for CTE programs at high schools to improve access to equipment, software, trainings, and industry certification tests.

See Appendix A for a list of the counties awarded SPARC grants for each of the three years and the amount of awards by county. The rural counties that received SPARC funding have all historically struggled to meet established state goals regarding student postsecondary access and success.^H

Grant recipients could use SPARC funds for:

- purchasing additional CTE equipment to enable students to pursue industry credentialing or postsecondary credits;
- work-based learning experiences;
- industry certification exams;
- teacher professional development; and
- purchasing, as a packaged program, an appropriate dual enrollment course in partnership with a Tennessee College of Applied Technology (TCAT), including the cost of establishing a dual enrollment opportunity or adult learner opportunity within a high school facility.

Examples of counties' uses of SPARC funds for CTE

- The Hancock County Career and Technical Center received a \$75,000 grant in 2019 to fully equip its new welding shop with industry grade equipment.
- Lauderdale County Schools and TCAT Ripley received a \$75,000 grant for a dual enrollment welding program between the two institutions. The program, located on the Ripley High School campus, is open to 11th and 12th graders at both Halls High School and Ripley High School.
- In 2019, the Hawkins County Schools' CTE program received a \$35,921 grant to expand CTE programs at Cherokee High School and Volunteer High School. Cherokee High School used the money to improve its nursing skills lab and purchase software for the Architectural and Engineering Design program and OSHA 10 training (a course in the basics of occupational safety and health).
- In 2022, Hawkins County Schools received a second SPARC grant of \$100,000 to buy shop furniture (i.e., work benches and shelves) and tools for its new machine tool CTE course. Hawkins County received additional assistance to start the program from TCAT Morristown, which was awarded a \$1 million Governor's Investment in Vocational Education (GIVE) grant.^I TCAT Morristown used \$250,000 of its GIVE grant to purchase most of the machines Hawkins County Schools needed to start the machine tool program, including five manual lathes, five manual mills, one computer numerical control (CNC) mill, one CNC lathe, and standard shop equipment such as band saws.
- In 2021, the Grundy County High School CTE department received \$223,825 in SPARC funding to purchase CTE equipment and industry certification tests for students.

- In 2021, Lewis County Schools’ CTE department received a SPARC grant of \$124,703. The district is using the funds to create a mock hospital and exam room and purchase healthcare training simulators for the health science department to replicate clinical scenarios for students; purchase live streaming equipment, editing equipment, and supplies for the technology department allowing students to produce live-streamed school events; purchase a wood lathe and supplies for the construction department to help students create and produce a school-based enterprise making various products; and upgrade facilities, including the greenhouse and irrigation line, hydroponics system, animal anatomies and flower models, bovine simulators, and rotary indexer. The district expects the purchases to promote student experiences with various industries and move them faster and further in dual enrollment and postsecondary programs and eventually to high-demand, high-wage jobs.

Innovative School Model (ISM) Grants

The Tennessee Department of Education (TDOE) has issued two rounds of grant funding – one using federal funding in 2021 and one using state funding starting in 2022 – challenging districts to develop Innovative School Models in middle and high schools that require rethinking when, where, and how students learn in order to accelerate and increase student attainment of high-quality, in-demand postsecondary credentials.

Reimagining the use of time, space, and modes of learning = rethinking when, where, and how students learn.

In May 2021, TDOE used \$30 million in ESSER federal funding to award competitive grants to 21 districts for the development of Innovative School Models. Grant award amounts ranged from \$750,000 to \$2 million. Along with reimagining the use of time, space, and modes of learning, districts were to describe how they planned to develop strategic partnerships with postsecondary education institutions as well as local businesses. (See Appendix B for a list of the 21 districts and a summary of their strategic partnerships.)

By 2023, TDOE awarded more than \$560 million in one-time state funding for Innovative School Model (ISM) grants made available for every public middle and high school in the state.

TDOE describes the ISM grant program as a strategy to foster a culture of college and career awareness and readiness by empowering schools to transform the traditional high school and middle school models.¹ (See Appendix C for a list of all schools that received ISM grants as of May 2023.)

To obtain funding, districts (or individual schools) had to submit grant proposals clearly outlining how they would reimagine time, space, partnerships, and modes of learning and showing commitments from at least one postsecondary partner. Grant proposals also had to include a sustainability plan to ensure the innovation could last beyond the life of the grant.


Grant recipients received \$1 million per high school and \$500,000 per middle school. Combination schools, or schools that serve both middle and high school students, were awarded \$1 million each, and \$500,000 was awarded to those that serve elementary and middle school students. Grant funding was capped at \$200,000 for schools with fewer than 100 students.

Examples of districts' uses of first-round ISM grant funding

- ***Milan, Trenton, and Gibson County Special Schools*** formed a consortium and sought area community groups and employers as partners. The consortium's innovative school model allows students to attend high school through a modified school day at a participating employer's facility instead of the traditional classroom setting. Grant funds were also used to purchase CTE equipment, such as forklifts, punch presses, and safety controls to help students get hands-on training in the classroom. Other equipment purchased included EKG machines, patient lifts, and IV tubing for health sciences students.
- ***Jackson-Madison County Schools*** established Innovation Impact Institutes at each of its seven high schools. Each institute has a specialized focus on a different high-demand occupation. Because the district has open enrollment, students can access any institute and field of interest. District officials were able to build on existing programs and structures, including a work-based learning model for manufacturing courses (i.e., the Local Options and Opportunities Program (LOOP) and the virtual academy that opened during the pandemic). Students can gain stackable credentials in workforce certifications; engage in work-based learning opportunities, including paid and unpaid internships; and take dual enrollment and dual credit programs. The district designed the Innovation Impact Institutes to allow students opportunities to engage in work-based learning (WBL) at times that work for them and the employer. WBL can occur during any block of the school day, for example. The district also offers some classes after school hours, with teachers paid stipends to teach them. Notable student learning experiences have included:
 - building electric cars through the Greenpower program;^K
 - writing and publishing a magazine through the Madison Humanities Innovation Institute;
 - building a commercial-grade triple axle trailer for the Solar Powered Tiny House Project at the South Side High School Institute of Advanced Carpentry;
 - starting a drone program and an eSports competitive team as part of the Jackson Academic STEAM Academy (JASA); and
 - building furniture for the North Side High School (NSHS) American Law & Justice Impact Institute's mock courtroom; students from the South Side High School's Institute of Advanced Carpentry built the furniture.
- Philadelphia Elementary School in ***Loudon County Schools*** embeds STEM and CTE courses into middle school curricula, giving students the opportunity to explore career pathways and identify their interests early.
- ***Bristol Tennessee City Schools*** established an off-site program called Viking Academy for students struggling with credit accumulation and attendance who have had difficulty in a traditional school setting. The district was able to leverage various donations and community relationships to move the program forward and reduce costs. The district renovated a former car dealership that had been donated and already had shop bay lifts, which could accommodate one of the CTE programs offered in specialized automotive instruction. Renovations were completed under the supervision of a full-time

administrator who manages all aspects of the program including hiring, community engagement, and data and financial management. The city of Bristol contributes the school resource officer (SRO) salary for the facility and a local business partner contributes the salary for the full-time career counselor position. Students at Viking Academy are placed in cohorts of 12-14 students, allowing students more support from core content teachers.

Appendix B: Innovative High School Models grant awardees, May 2021

Hamblen County Schools

Turning Pathways into Highways is a Workforce Ready Partnership with Cocke County Schools to move students through career awareness, exploration, and immersion via high quality CTE programs of study.

Gibson County Special School District

The Pathways to Success Project allows students to attend high school through a modified school day at a partnering employer's facility instead of the traditional classroom setting on a high school campus while also participating in a Career Advisement Program.

Gibson County Special School District joined Milan Special School district and Trenton Special School District as a consortium under the grant. The consortium sought community groups and employers within the county to partner with.

Rutherford County Schools

Empower Today's Students to Grasp Tomorrow's Opportunities will offer industry certification training classes after school hours and allow students to participate in employer-led boot camps on jobs to learn soft and entry-level skills.

Macon County Schools

TAPPING Beyond Boundaries will support a state-of-art TAP Program of Study for students from Macon and Jackson Counties by accelerating and developing the next generation of teachers by reimagining modes of learning, time, and partnerships.

Clarksville-Montgomery County School System

The vision of CMCSS and this partnership is to be the leaders in innovative workforce development by meeting the vital needs of business and industry through the reimagining of the high school model with meaningful and seamless transitions from secondary to postsecondary to careers.

Bradley County Schools

PIE Innovation Center will create an innovative student experience through collaboration with business, industry, and nonprofit organizations changing learning pathways, providing experiential learning in STEM, embedded work-based learning experiences, and the promotion of design thinking.

Memphis-Shelby County Schools

Shelby County Schools will transform Bolton High School into a nationally prominent AgriSTEM high school where time, space, partnerships, and modes of learning have been reimagined throughout the school.

Oak Ridge City Schools

Oak Ridge will be creating i-School, an integrative ecosystem learning model that includes a school-based enterprise for solving real-world problems with interactive models and design thinking. The district will collaborate with Roane State Community College, the University of Tennessee, and Oak Ridge National Laboratories Manufacturing Demonstration Facility (ORNL MDF).

Wilson County Schools

Wilson County Early College will grow its own workforce in high-demand, high-wage careers by aligning middle school and high school CTE programs to early college programs that allow students to earn industry certifications and associate degrees while in high school.

Cheatham County Schools

Cheatham County Schools – in partnership with the Tennessee College of Applied Technology (TCAT) Nashville, Cheatham County Economic and Community Development Board, and Cheatham County businesses A.O. Smith and Nashville Fabrication – will create a welding and automotive pipeline program in order to ensure a strong future workforce in both Cheatham County and Middle Tennessee.

Hardeman County Schools

Hosted primarily at Lone Oaks Farm, an outdoor STEM education center of the University of Tennessee Institute of Agriculture, a new high school program will give students an opportunity to gain postsecondary credit and obtain industry approved credentialing and professional certifications.

Alcoa City Schools

TCAT Knoxville and the Alcoa High School Tornadoes – Funneling Students Into Successful Health Care Careers – will allow students to become part of the nursing pipeline for the area healthcare industry by reducing barriers to early postsecondary opportunities and providing supports and experiences so that all students can achieve success.

Collierville Schools

Collierville High School will collaborate with Helena Chemical, Rantizo Drones, and the local global transportation and logistics company FedEx to provide a pathway to career opportunity in the agricultural industry as well as in the transportation/logistics pathway.

Hamilton County Schools

Hamilton County Schools and Chattanooga State Community College will create a MicroCollege program to provide a core set of introductory college courses during high school and offer a supportive environment in which students can earn dual credit toward their high school diploma and introductory college courses.

Bristol Tennessee City Schools

The new Tennessee High School Viking Career Center, an off-site innovative alternative learning program, will provide personalized educational and work-based learning options for students who choose an alternative pathway.

Carter County Schools

Carter County Schools will partner with Northeast State Community College and TCAT Elizabethton to better prepare students for career readiness.

Cumberland County Schools

Cumberland County Schools will partner with Azure Flight Support to assist with the development of a training curriculum and provide expertise to train simulator instructors in flight.



Wayne County Schools

Collinwood High School will transform the Bevis Educational Center into a forestry training center for students to take traditional and postsecondary coursework and access work-based learning opportunities.

Jackson-Madison County Schools

Innovation Impact Institutes will be created through a partnership between JMCSS and community organizations and postsecondary institutions to provide educational experiences for students through nontraditional schedules, learner-paced curriculum, and work-based learning opportunities.

Tullahoma City Schools

Tullahoma Virtual Academy (TVA) will provide students three possible pathways for accessing TVA courses: full-time virtual, FLEX, and part-time virtual. Students will have the ability to customize their high school experience and support their individual needs.

Sequatchie County Schools

Reimagine Sequatchie County High School by Building UP STEAM will provide students with work-based learning opportunities, internships, apprentice opportunities, practicum experiences, and dual enrollment opportunities with partners in the community.
