

Direct Funding Overview

Direct funding is intended to support students in key priority areas. Direct funding is 100 percent state-funded and does not require a local contribution. The funds are a flat amount provided on a per student or ADM basis.



K-3 Literacy

Funding is intended to support early literacy instruction.

All students in grades K-3

Grade 4 Literacy Support

Funding is intended to provide students with additional literacy-related supports, such as tutoring and other interventions.

ACT for Grades 11 and 12

Funding for all 11th graders to take the ACT and be provided with a retake opportunity in grade 12. All students in grades 11-12

Charter Schools

The annual appropriation for charter schools is divided across all public charter schools based on student enrollment.

Career and Technical Education (CTE)

Funding is for students who participate in CTE courses.
